Any violation of the should be reported to the Dean of Students, where it may be addressed pursuant to the <u>University of Southern Mississippi Student Code of Conduct</u>. Violations may be deferred to the judicial bodies of the Interfraternity Council (IFC), College Panhellenic Council (CPC), or National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC).

Any individual or organization found to be in violation of these guidelines, or other policies governing student conduct, may be subject to all disciplinary provisions of the <u>University of Southern Mississippi Student Code of Conduct</u> and may be subject to separate criminal and/or civil liability.

In addition to disciplinary action by the University, individuals and organizations may also be subject to disciplinary action of local or inter/national groups.
