## **STUDENT MEDIA CENTER: Open House**

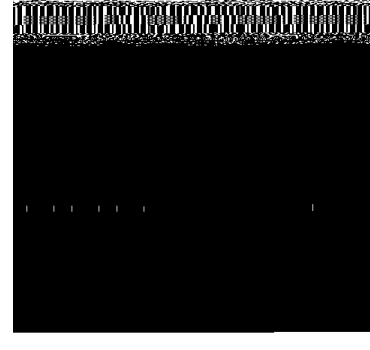
The Southern Miss Student Media Center, or SM2, is the voice of USM students. This is where students collaborate with professional staff and their faculty advisers to create, inspire and inform.
